My name is Missy Rossing, and I am the Executive Director of the Home-Based Educator's Accrediting Association (HBEAA). HBEAA has recently been recognized by the NCAA as a Homeschool Umbrella Program, which allows us to better assist homeschooled athletes who are registering with the NCAA Eligibility Center to be certified as eligible to play NCAA sports. If you have a homeschooled student athlete interested in the NCAA, we can help! We also offer assistance to those who are applying to other colleges and technical schools.

HBEAA, currently, is the only accrediting association for homeschools approved and recognized by the State of Minnesota under the auspices of the Non-Public Education Council. While accrediting is not necessary to homeschool in Minnesota, we have found many of our families benefit greatly from the organization, accountability, and direction we offer. We accredit both full-time homeschools and homeschools that do shared-time with their public schools or PSEO courses.

Parent educators are provided with ongoing recordkeeping, as well as, an official transcript and a diploma issued by an accredited school, which can be advantageous when applying to colleges, for scholarships, and verification of a high school diploma for the military and technical schools.
